Rules and Guidelines of the 12th International Fine Arts Competition ''Family Portrait. Time of pandemic'' Lublin 2021

Competition's guidelines:

- It is a full and open competition.
- It is a one-stage competition.
- Criteria for participation:
- The participants must be aged 15 20. There are two age categories: 15-17 and 18-20.
- One participant may submit a maximum of 3 art pieces created in the years 2020 2021, which have never taken part in any other competitions.
- A school may submit up to 5 art pieces (per category) created in the years 2020 2021, which have never taken part in any other competition. The school should attach a **submission form** to the set of art pieces. / *appendix 1*/;
- The participants are required to attach the following documents to each submission:
 - 1) a **certificate** which includes information on the submission /appendix 2/;
 - 2) **the participant's identifier** /appendix 3/ in a sealed envelope marked with a crest of choice;
 - 3) Consent to the use of personal data /appendix 4/. It should be sealed in an envelope containing the participant's identifier.
- Each participant is required to use a crest of choice instead of their full name, it can take a form of a pseudonym or a numerical code for instance: /crest CROW15/.
- Participation is equivalent to agreeing to the use of the piece in promotional materials, free of charge.
- The winning pieces are to become the property of the organiser, the remaining submissions are going to be sent back, no later than 30th September 2021, the postal fee (delivery service prices apply) is going to be paid by the participants.
- Submissions may become the property of the organiser if the head teachers of the respective interested schools decide so.

Competition categories:

- 1. Artistic black and white photography /minimal width of the shorter edge 18 cm/
- 2. Drawing /A3 B1/;
- 3. Painting /minimal width of the shorter edge 40 cm, maximum width of the longer edge 150 cm/;
- 4. Printmaking /minimal width of the shorter edge 10 cm/;
- 5. Computer graphics /A3 B1/;
- 7. Artistic tapestry;
- 8. A short film or an animation / duration time up to 5 minutes, approved formats WMV, MPG (2,4), AVI./;

Files burned on a CD/DVD, along with printed appendixes 1, 2, 3 should be sent via post on the address of the school.

Selecting and announcing the winners:

- Jury consisting of fine arts school teachers and university teachers will assess works submitted in time provided (till 26th March). First, they will select works which qualify for the exhibition, then they will proceed to award competition winners as well as those listed as "other" (the award for most prominent artistic personality and sponsored awards).
- Works will be assessed on 2nd April 2021
- Jugdes are going to assess submissions separately for two different age groups: 15-17 year olds and 18-20 year olds in all categories using the following criteria:
 - 1) originality
 - 2) maturity of the skill

- 3) maturity of artistic expression
- For each criterion there is 10 points to receive (30 points max.)
- Pieces which receive more than half of these points will qualify for the exhibition.
- Participants who receive the most points are the winners. If two participants receive the same number of points they will be awarded equally.
- Participants who are selected for awards listed in the rules and guidelines as well as those who are selected for other awards are considered finalists.
- 29th April 2010, 12 PM the opening of the post-competition exhibition, the award ceremony / the winners are going to receive a notice via post and are going to be invited to the opening of the exhibition/.

Awards:

- GRAND PRIX 1500 PLN / one winner chosen out of all of the participants/
- 1st degree award 1000 PLN /one for each age group/
- 2nd degree award 800 PLN /one for each age group/
- 3rd degree award 500 PLN /one for each age group/

Other awards:

- The award for the artistic personality which stands out the most -500,00 PLN /one winner chosen out of all of the participants/
- The Head Teacher's award
- awards sponsored by supervising institutions

The Competition Committee reserves the right to divide the awards listed in the guidelines in a different way.

The Competition Committee is appointed by The Ministry of Culture and National Heritage at the request of the Head Teacher of The Norwid Secondary School of Fine Arts in Lublin.

Warning: Submissions which do not abide by the rules are not going to be accepted nor assessed by the judges.
